⁴ One credit of a practical art is required for graduation. Computer fulfills that requirement and can be taken any year as the class is available. Preference will be given to seniors who need the credit to meet graduation requirements.

⁵ One credit of Physical Education and one half credit of Health are required for 2010. This course may be taken any year as the class is available. Preference will be given to seniors who need the credit to meet graduation requirements.

⁶ A half credit of Financial Management is required for graduation beginning in 2010. This course may be taken any year as the class is available. Preference will be given to seniors who need the credit to meet graduation requirements.
